Voting activity for college students compared to regular voters

2020 Election

2020 Election saw record numbers as 66% of college students voted

- These numbers are up 13% since last election cycle
- Midterm turnout also rose by almost doubling up to 39.1%



MSSU Student Poll

MSSU students were surveyed and asked the following questions: Are you registered to vote? Have you ever voted before? Do you plan on voting in November and who for?

- 74% registered
- Significantly higher than national average
- 47% have previously voted
- 75% plan to vote in November
- 21% know who they are voting for



Midterms

Midterms are held halfway through the Presidential election cycle

All 50 states vote on their seats for the House of Representatives

In the cycle, 34 senate seats will be voted on including representatives from Missouri, Kansas, Arkansas and Oklahoma



Midterm Governors

Some states also vote on their governors

States that vote on Governors

Alabama, Alaska, Arizona, Arkansas, California, Colorado, Connecticut, Florida, Georgia, Hawaii, Idaho, Illinois, Iowa, Kansas, Maine, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Nebraska, Nevada, New Hampshire, New Mexico, New York, Ohio, Oklahoma, Oregon, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, South Carolina, South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, Vermont, Wisconsin, and Wyoming
